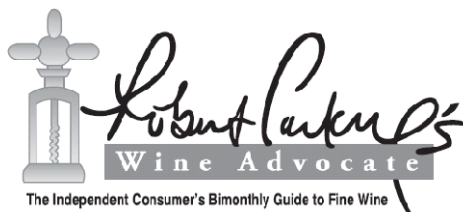

## More Great Reviews for Neudorf Wines



### 90 points 2008 Brightwater Riesling

*"The 2008 Brightwater Riesling gives intense lemon lime aromas with some slate, orange blossom and coriander seed. Crisp, tight and still very youthful in the mouth, this is a light to medium bodied dry style with a hint of sweetness (8 grams per liter of residual sugar). The finish is long and long and steely. It is refreshing now but should mellow with another year in bottle, drinking to 2016+."*



### 91 points 2009 Moutere Riesling

*"The 2009 Moutere Riesling is a medium-sweet, lower alcohol style possessing 47 grams per liter of residual sugar and 9% alcohol. It gives a restrained, moderate intensity of earthy, chalky, musky notes over lemon peel and lime leaf aromas. Effortlessly, invigoratingly sweet, there's a great line of acid running through the middle contributing superb balance and lingering through the long, steely finish. It should drink best from 2012 to 2017+."*



### 90 points 2008 Neudorf Chardonnay

*"The 2008 Chardonnay provides a moderate to intense, pleasantly wild and funky nose with notes of meal, pineapple, warm grapefruit, struck match, baking bread and nuts. The medium bodied palate is toasty and well textured with just enough viscosity, crisp acid and a long toasty finish. Approachable now, it should drink best 2011 to 2015+."*



### 91+ points 2008 Moutere Chardonnay

*"The 2008 Moutere Chardonnay is youthfully mute, citric, with supporting aromas of peaches and orange blossom plus whiffs of toast, almonds and oatmeal. Tight knit, very crisp, minerally and tense, this medium bodied Chardonnay gives a long pure lemon cream finish at this juncture. Give it another year or so in bottle and consider drinking it 2012 to 2016+."*



### 90 points 2008 Tom's Block Pinot Noir

*"Pale to medium ruby purple colored, the 2008 Tom's Block Pinot Noir presents moderately pronounced ripe cherry, black raspberry and game aromas over nuances of tar, humus, black truffles and black pepper. Crisp in the mouth with good concentration, a medium body and medium level of grainy tannins, it gives a long earthy/savory finish. It's good now though it should develop nicely over the next 4-5 years."*



### 91+ points 2008 Moutere Pinot Noir

*"Displaying a medium ruby color, the 2008 Moutere Pinot Noir has black cherry and red currant aromas with an undercurrent of smoky bacon, underbrush, damp loam and bark plus a little anise. Medium bodied, this is an elegant, well structured style with a good backbone of high acid and medium level of very fine tannins. It has beguiling layers of cranberry, meat and mushroom flavors, finishing with very good persistence. Consider drinking this one 2012 to 2016+."*
