## **Grey's Peak 2009 Riesling**

Lovely aromatic profile and brilliance from low pH levels and high limestone slopes. Lots of orange and lime blossom on the nose, fresh lime juice and honeyed orange peel on the palate.



## **Grey's Peak 2009 Sauvignon Blanc**

This wine is a wonderful example of why Sauvignon Blanc is considered an aromatic white wine. The nose has lovely floral notes grounded by just-picked gooseberries and green peas. This is supported by classic Grey's Peak minerality on the palate, almost a tingling chalkiness and a lovely linear length and finish.



## **Grey's Peak 2008 Pinot Noir**

***Elite Gold Medal Winner – 2009 Air New Zealand Wine Awards***

A complex array of sweet berry fruit with hints of cloves and spice on the nose. The palate has a luscious full-bodied entry with smooth integrated tannins giving way to a lingering finish of fresh juicy acidity. Flavors of wild blackberry and ripe raspberries combined with an earthiness and mild spice.
