Tri-Nations win for Neudorf

Neudorf Vineyards scooped the “Best White Wine” award at the Tri-Nations Wine Challenge held in Sydney earlier this month.

The 2007 Neudorf “Moutere” Chardonnay collected the trophy for “Top Chardonnay” then went on to win “Best White Wine” of the competition.

Judy Finn admits that the winery doesn’t enter wine competitions, however does compete in the Tri-Nations Wine Challenge (wines judged from New Zealand, South Africa and Australia) as top wine writers from each of the three countries enter their personal choices – these are then judged against the competition. *“Great for Neudorf, great for New Zealand and especially excellent for all those small wineries battling away in a world of increasing corporatisation,” she said.*

2009 has been a stunning year for Neudorf – being named New Zealand’s Greatest Winery in Tom Stephenson’s *UK Wine Report* earlier this year.

Established in 1978 by Tim and Judy Finn, Neudorf has long been the epitome of that elusive dream - small winery producing great wines and having a good time doing it.

“We are very lucky to have a special bit of dirt here in Upper Moutere - deep gravelly clays bathed in a warm Nelson sun,” Judy said. “Our job is to make sure we don’t make a cock up.”
